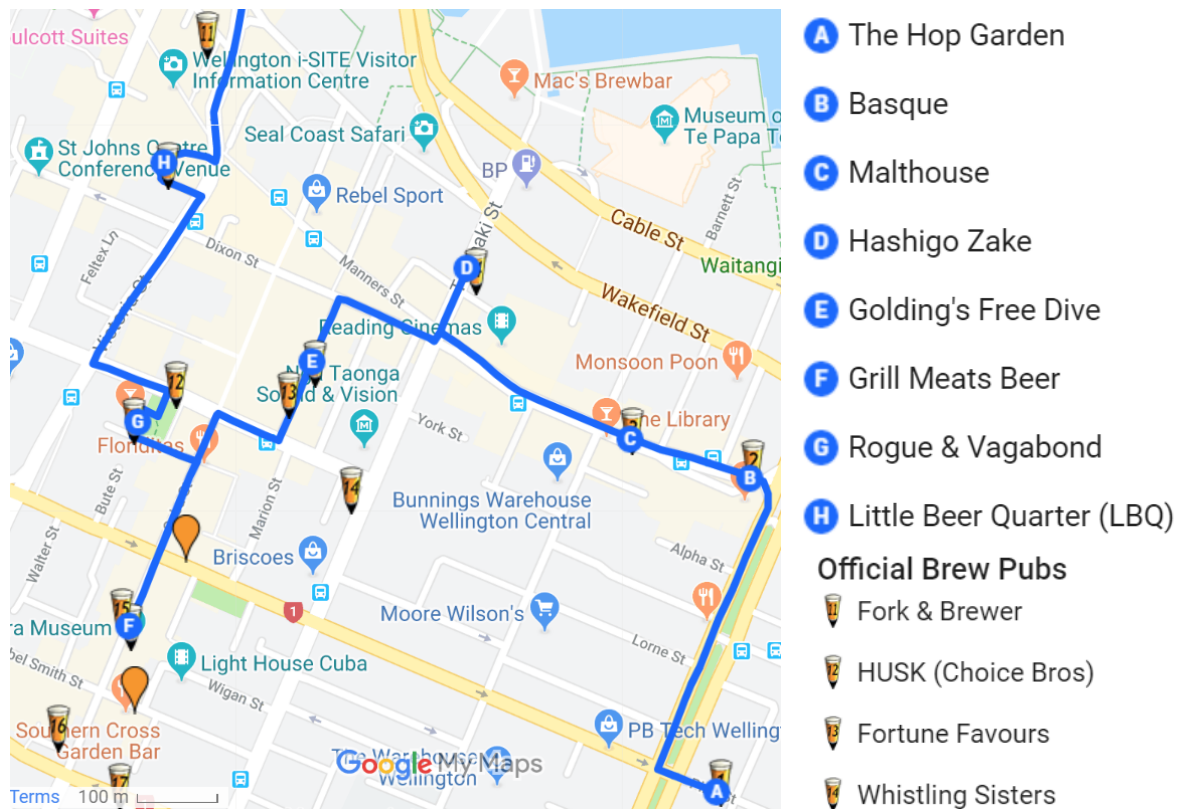


# Real Ale in Wellington

My personalised trail would be the following:

- 1. Hashigo Zake (D)**, downstairs from a doorway in an alley off Taranaki Street
- 2. Golding's Free Dive (E)**, Hannahs laneway, an American Dive bar in Wellington shouldn't fit in, but this one really does. or **Fortune Favours (13)**, Hannahs laneway, is new and gaining an encouraging reputation.
- 3. HUSK (12)**, Ghuznee Street, brewery, bar, coffee roastery & eatery. or **Rogue & Vagabond (G)**, in Park by Ghuznee Street, 19 Beer taps.
- 4. Little Beer Quarter – LBQ (H)**, Edward St Precinct, hidden away so a quiet and friendly place to chill.
- 5. Fork & Brewer (11)**, Bond Street, upstairs to a brew bar with literally 40 different taps.

There are many other great choices further away: Southern Cross (16), The Hop Garden (A) or close good choices Mac's or St John's (waterfront).
